



Acceptance of Optomap Digital Imaging of the Retina

Our doctor highly recommends a screening device that takes a photo of the back of your eye to help diagnose eye disease. It is a procedure similar to dilation but without the eye drops and difficulty focusing after the exam. This device also allows for a permanent record for documentation to monitor for changes that may occur in the future. Without this procedure, the doctor can only see about 10% of the inside of your eye. Many eye problems can develop without warning and progress with no symptoms. Having it done, the doctor can see the rest of the eye and detect problems that you cannot feel or see until your vision is impaired.

It is a very fast, simple and comfortable procedure that produces invaluable information. It is recommended yearly for everyone and is especially important to rule out certain eye diseases if you have a history of high blood pressure, diabetes, headaches, migraines, floaters, flashes, a high glasses prescription, retinal problems, glaucoma or a family history of eye disease.

This new technology is not covered by any health insurance and its fee is \$35 when performed on the day of the exam.
